Matthew 5:13-16

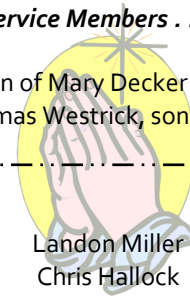
*"You are the salt of the earth, the light of the world!"*
