John 16:12-15

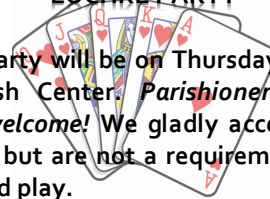
"Father, Son and Holy Spirit!"

The Youth Mental Health First Aid Course is intended for adults to learn how to help young people. It reviews the unique risk factors and warning signs of mental health problems in adolescents ages 12—18 and emphasizes the importance of early intervention.

Topics covered include: Anxiety; Depression; Substance Abuse; Eating Disorders; Disruptive Behavior; Psychosis

8 continuing education hours will be awarded upon completion for nurses, nursing home administrators, occupational therapists, physical therapists, social workers and counselors.

8 professional development hours will be awarded to school teachers upon completion.
