It's official!

Before Fr. Powell went to Guest House, there was a conversation with the Diocese of Joliet about when St. Mary's in Beaverville would no longer be staffed by a priest of the Viatorian Religious Order, and which area parish would take responsibility for serving the needs there. The following is the note sent to inform us of the coming change:

"Dear Parishioners of St. Edmund's Parish in Watseka and St. Mary's Parish in Beaverville,

Beautiful St. Mary's Church and its community has been under the care of the pastor of St. George, but will now shift to the care of the pastor of St. Edmund's in Watseka, effective January 15, 2022.

Many thanks to Fr. Belanger for his service to the community these past years. I am sure Fr. Powell will give the same care going forward. Thank you to the parishioners of St. Mary's. The local priests speak highly of the community and their commitment to one another in the service of Christ."
