**Please consider volunteering at the Watseka Area Food Pantry!** The hours would be between 9:00—11:30 any weekday morning. Volunteers help by answering the phone, calling clients to get food orders, filling the orders, and stocking shelves. Clients pick up their orders by "curbside delivery."

In the first 6 months of 2022, there have been 46% more requests for food assistance than there were during the same period of time in 2021. This ministry of area churches benefits ALL people of Iroquois County who are food-insecure.
